## Disney rococo

We're not trying to create a regular slot for Jaime Hayón at *Crafts* but the Spanish-born designer is hard to avoid these days. In *American Chateau Room One*, his latest installation (11 September – 22 October), he rejoins forces with regular collaborator (and *Crafts* photographer) Nienke Klunder. Taking place at London's Spring Projects, this new series of sculptural and two-dimensional pieces is inspired by two very distinct sources: American pop icons and the opulence of 17th-century European craftwork. The gallery itself describes it, rather neatly, as Versailles meets Disney. And we have to confess that we're weirdly fascinated by *The Rocking Hot Dog*, a large, playful sculpture made by a Formula One body manufacturer that visitors will be encouraged to straddle. ## Design squared

Two years after launching, DesignArt London has rebranded. Now called the Pavilion of Art & Design London, the Berkeley Square-based fair runs parallel with *Frieze*, from 14-18 October. The new name brings a slightly different focus – like the Pavilion des Arts et du Design Paris, its sister show across the Channel, the revamped exhibition will display fine art alongside high-end design and craft. A smattering of new exhibitors is promised, such as Belgian galleries Anne Autegarde and Rapin-Müllendorff – but several familiar names have returned. Galleries to look out for include the London-based Louisa Guinness, Adrian Sassoon and the Carpenters Workshop Gallery, as well as the likes of Alain Marcelpoil and Jean-David Botella from Paris.
